### STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

### **Description:**

The Rossland Tennis Courts are located in a residential area in the north east portion of Rossland and accessed just off Park Street. The present property takes up seven 30 foot x 100 foot lots. The three courts take up the majority of that area.

### **Heritage Value:**

The continuous use of the Rossland Tennis Courts, their ongoing maintenance and periodic refurbishment over the past hundred years, speak to the long-held appreciation Rosslanders

have for tennis, recreation and outdoor pursuits. A society of interested people has always directed the operation and organization of tennis in Rossland. This shows that the opportunities the courts provide for skill development, competition and exercise are not only utilized but valued.

An identifiable characteristic of Rossland culture is the integration of outdoor sport and social activities; the Rossland Tennis Courts are another example of this aspect of Rossland culture, which has been true for over 110 years.

- Practice and storage area.
- High fence surrounding the courts.
- Public access.
